MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING HELD JUNE 15, 2004

PRAYER and FLAG SALUTE: Darleen Hemmerlin

TEEN CENTER: Tom Amato made a presentation of the Teen Center. He invited Board members to be present for the opening. They need \$20,000 of the proposed budget of \$40,000. The Teen Center is expected to be open three days a week.

WEB SITE: Rosemary briefed the Board on what is needed for the proposed web site, and showed some samples of what can be done. It was voted to set aside \$500 to start the web site for 6 months.

MINUTES: The minutes of the May meeting were approved.

TREAS. RPT.: The Treasurer's report was accepted as corrected.

AMBULANCE: Noel Ojeda reported that there has been some improvement in the dispatching. The training/demonstration of the new life support equipment will be held June 28.

FIRE DEPT.: The new Rescue 18 is now in service, and the old one has been sold. There are plans for the County to furnish a loaner water tender until our new one has arrived. It was voted to appoint Ken Trumble as Chief while Chief Browne is on leave.

CERT TRAINING: It was voted to ask that the proposed CERT training be arranged for January or February.

CRESTWOOD: There will be a hearing on June 16 regarding Crestwood. The hearing will be held in the Supervisors' chamber.

CONSORTIUM: A consortium has been working on getting our fair share of the funds that was voted for flood and water under Measure A. They will meet again in July. For more information, call 965-2047 in the p.m.

FIREHOUSE APRON: More planning and fund raising is needed before final action can take place to repair the parking space in the front of the firehouse.
